

Interruption of Water Service Newkirk and Summit in Jersey City

Residents who live in the areas listed below may have no water, low water pressure or discolored water due to scheduled water system improvements.

Start: Saturday, November 8 at 5 a.m.

End: Saturday, November 8 at approximately 6 p.m.

Areas affected: Newkirk Street between Summit Avenue and Baldwin Avenue.
Summit Avenue between Academy Street and Sip Avenue.

United Water will shut down a 20-inch water main in order to replace a 20-inch valve. As a result, customers in the areas listed above may have no water, low water pressure or discolored water while the work is in progress. Additional shutdowns are scheduled for November 15, 22 and December 6.

The company suggests that customers fill containers and the bathtub on Friday night so they have water to use on Saturday. In addition, customers are asked to use water for essential purposes only while the work is in progress.

Water may be temporarily discolored during this time. While it is safe, customers may prefer to wait until the water runs clear before using it for drinking, cooking or washing clothes or dishes.

United Water and the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority work hard to provide customers with the highest quality water service. Valve replacement is part of the JCMUA's ongoing water system improvement program. Valves are used to control the flow of water and are critical to the safe and reliable operation of the water system.
